





At Piber - They also have a small carriage collection.







Treasurer's Report

On January 14th, Spokes and Spurs hosted a successful and well attended annual membership meeting at the offices of the Carriage Association of America, located at the Kentucky Horse Park. Members enjoyed a lunch catered by Cracker Barrel, desserts provided by attendees, our popular silent auction which brought in \$623.00, and last, but not least, an enjoyable time with other driving enthusiasts.



During the meeting, I provided the Treasurer's Report with a concise account of club finances. At the beginning of the year, the club's account balance with WesBanco was \$5,259.22. Receipts for the calendar year totaled \$5,433.00 (membership and dues) while expenses totaled \$6,366.05. These figures resulted in a 2023 year-end balance of \$4,336.17.

During 2023 checks were issued, including reimbursements to Ann Katona and David Gaston for various club expenses.

Principal expenses were:

- MCF LLC Stacey Giere clinician \$1,200.00
- American Reliable for liability insurance \$507.30
- Betty Orlieb for CT judging fee \$250
- Betty Ortlieb for mini-CDE judging fee \$250.00
- Deb Halsted for 6 walkie-talkies \$224.70
- Dana Banfield for cone measuring sticks \$180.00

• Blue Host for website hosting - \$139.79

Memberships for 2023 were similar to the recent past. The club received 59 memberships in 2023 comprising 31 family and 28 single, with 105 actual members. The club is on a sound financial footing and I'm happy to continue as Treasurer until such time that someone else would like to take over.

For 2024, we appreciate members paying their dues in a timely manner as this funds the club's various activities. Our hard working volunteer board has scheduled a full series of events for 2024 which will of course incur costs by the club. Many thanks are due to the CAA's John Stallard and Ann Katona for recently preparing and mailing renewal notices to the membership. This initiative clearly worked as renewals are coming in steadily. So far this year, I have received 36 memberships (36 family and 10 single) and I anticipate more in the coming weeks. The club's current balance is \$5,553.75.
